Understanding Salvation

The Problem...

Human beings have a natural desire to **be the boss** and to ignore God's principles for living. This ignorance to God's way of living is communicated in our words and lifestyle:

- "If it feels good, do it! Regardless of what God has to say about it?" "It's my life and I'll do what I please!"

THE BIBLE CALL THIS ATTITUDE **SIN**.

Sin is a Biblical word that means "to miss the mark."

Key Word: **Rebellion**

"All of us, like sheep, have gone astray, and each of us has turned to his own way." Isaiah 53:6

"If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us." 1John 1:8

Sin breaks our close relationship with God. Sin separates us from God and causes us to live our lives outside of His will.

...your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear. Isaiah 59:2

All have sinned and fall short of the glory of. Romans 3:23

The Solution...


*Jesus said, "I AM THE WAY, the Truth, and the Life. No one comes to the Father, except **through Me!**" John 14:6*

*If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
1 John 1:9*

BELIEVE THAT JESUS DIED TO PAY FOR YOUR SINS AND THAT HE ROSE AGAIN, AND IS ALIVE TODAY.

*That if you confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord”, and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.
Romans 10:9*

*Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.
Acts 4:12*

RECEIVE GOD’S FREE GIFT OF SALVATION. DON’T TRY TO EARN IT.

*For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, that no one should boast.

Our relationship to God is not restored by anything we do, but on the basis of what Jesus has already done for us!

IF YOU BELIEVE YOU BELONG!

*“Everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord will be saved.”

After you make a commitment to trust Jesus, you enter into a lifelong relationship with God as a Christian. A Christian (a follower of Jesus) then attempts to learn more about:

- God
- His Character
- His desires for your life and lifestyle

Why should I be baptized?

TO FOLLOW THE EXAMPLE SET BY **CHRIST**.

*“At that time Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan.”
Mark 1:9*

BECAUSE CHRIST **COMMANDED** IT.

*Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.
Matt. 28:19-20*

IT DEMONSTRATES THAT I REALLY AM A **BELIEVER**.

“....many of the Corinthians who heard Him believed and were baptized” Acts 18:8

*“We know that we have come to know Him, if we obey His commands.”
1 John 2:3*

What is the meaning of baptism?

IT ILLUSTRATES JESUS' **BURIAL** AND **RESURRECTION**.

*“Christ died for our sins...He was buried...and He was raised on the third day.”
1 Corinthians 15:3-4*

Having been buried with him in baptism and raised with him through your faith in the power of God, who raised him from the dead. Colossians 2:12

IT ILLUSTRATES MY **NEW LIFE** AS A CHRISTIAN.

*We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.
Romans 6:4*

Baptism doesn't make you a believer, it demonstrates that you already believe. It's important to understand that baptism does not “save” you. You are “saved” only by your faith in Jesus.

*For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, that no one should boast.
Ephesians 2:8-9*

Baptism is like a wedding ring. It is the outward symbol of the commitment you make in your heart. It is an **outward** sign of an **inward** commitment.

Why be baptized by immersion?

JESUS WAS BAPTIZED THAT WAY.

As soon as Jesus was baptized, He went up out of the water... Matt. 3:16

EVERY BAPTISM IN THE **BIBLE** WAS BY IMMERSION.

(Example) "... then both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water and Philip baptized him. When they came up out of the water..." Acts 8:38-39

THE WORD "BAPTIZE" (Baptizo in the Greek) ACTUALLY MEANS "**TO DIP UNDER**".

IMMERSION BEST SYMBOLIZES A **BURIAL** AND **RESURRECTION**.

*Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!
2 Corinthians 5:17*

Who should be baptized?

EVERY PERSON WHO HAS **BELIEVED** IN CHRIST.

*"Those who accepted His message were baptized..."
Acts 2:41*

*"Simon himself believed and was baptized..."
Acts 8:13*

*"But when they believed Philip as he preached the Good News... and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women."
Acts 8:12*

What if I was baptized as a baby?

What a great question! Some churches baptize infants. At Barwick Road Baptist Church, we only baptize those who have made a decision to believe in Christ's death as the payment for their sin and His resurrection for their new life. In the Bible, men and women were baptized following their belief in Jesus.

The custom of infant baptism began about 300 years after the Bible was completed. It's a ceremony intended to emphasize a commitment between the parents and God on behalf of the child. During this ceremony, the parents promise to raise their child in the faith until the child is old enough to make his/her own personal confession of Christ.

At Barwick Road Baptist Church, we have a Dedication Service for infants and children that emphasize the parent's role in raising a child to follow Christ.

Therefore, if you were baptized as a baby, we encourage you to be baptized by immersion as a believer.

When should I be baptized?

AS SOON AS YOU HAVE **BELIEVED!**

"Those who accepted...were baptized...that day!" Acts 2:41

Then Philip began with the scripture and told him the Good News about Jesus. As they traveled along the road, they came to some water, and the eunuch said, "Look, Here is water! Why shouldn't I be baptized?"

And he gave orders to stop the chariot. Then both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water and Philip baptized him.

Acts 8:35-38

There is no reason to delay. As soon as you have decided to receive Christ into your life, you can and should be baptized. If you wait until you are "perfect" you'll never be ready.

- You can check with the Pastor or church office to find out when the next opportunity to be baptized is scheduled.
- You should talk to your family and discuss when the best time for you would be.



Our Mission

The purpose of our church is summarized in two key passages of scripture:

The Great Commission

“Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

The Great Commandment

“Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’ This is the first and the greatest commandment. And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’”

Matthew 22:37-39

Barwick Road Baptist Church accomplishes its mission through 5 key components of a New Testament church that are described in these two critical passages. Those components are **worship** (*Love the Lord*), **ministry** (*Love your neighbor*), **evangelism** (*go and make disciples*), **fellowship** (*baptizing them*), and **discipleship** (*teaching them*).

What is Worship?

WORSHIP IS: **EXRESSING LOVE TO GOD**

Key Word: **DEVOTION**

Singing (*Eph. 5:19*)

Praying (*Ps. 95.6*)

Giving (*1Cor. 16:1-2*) **Meditating** (*Hab. 2:20*)

Commitment (*Romans 12:1-2*) **Hearing the Word** (*John 17:17*)

Baptism (*Romans 6:3-4*)

Lord's Supper (*1 Cor. 11:23-26*)

We believe that worship is a lifestyle, not simply something you do on Sunday morning.

Worship is an expression of love to God. It stems from our relationship with Him. Therefore, worship is more of an attitude of the heart rather than it is an activity.

What is Ministry?

MINISTRY IS: **MEETING NEEDS WITH LOVE**

Key Word: **SERVE**

“By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.”

John 13:35

[See also: 1 John 3:16-17; Matt. 25:34-40; Heb. 13:16; Rom. 12:13]

There are different kinds of gifts, but the same spirit. There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it. 1 Corinthians 12:4-5, 27

Every member is a **Minister** with a **Ministry**.

What is Evangelism?

EVANGELISM IS: **SHARING THE GOOD NEWS**

Key Word: **REACH**

“His intent was that now, through the church, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known...” Ephesians 3:10

“Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? Romans 10: 13-14

Why our church must never stop growing:

1. GOD **REACHES OUT**

Think of your...

Jerusalem as: your family, close friends, co-workers

Judea as: individuals within our town

Samaria as: individuals within our country

Ends of the earth as: individuals around the world

3. GROWTH IS **GOD’S WILL**.

Jesus said, “...and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it.” Matthew 16:18

What is Fellowship?

FELLOWSHIP IS: **CONNECTING WITH OTHER BELIEVERS**

Key Word: **CONNECT**

The Biblical idea of fellowship involves connecting with other believers in a personal way. It involves supporting and encouraging each other. Fellowship involves praying together, bearing one another’s burdens, playing together, laughing together, sharing together and holding each other accountable to God’s purpose for our lives. We believe that being actively involved in the fellowship of our church is crucial to your growth as a Christian.

In essence, fellowship is “doing life” together.

We encourage you to be involved in...

Connection Group/Small Group Bible Study. We believe these opportunities are vital to your growth as a follower of Christ. It is in the Bible study where you gain valuable teachings and insight for your daily life. Without consistent Bible study and a regular time of fellowship with other believers to encourage you in your walk with God, your spiritual life will begin to dry up.

Therefore, we encourage you to be committed to weekly small group Bible study.

Worship. It is in worship where we gather as a family to exalt God. Not only is God glorified in worship, but the church is strengthened and encouraged as well. We believe that worship is critical to your spiritual well-being and therefore we place a high priority in your worship attendance.

Ministry. The Bible suggests that every member is a minister. Therefore, it is critical to the body of Christ that we help you find your special place in ministry. We realize that many of you may not be ready to jump right into ministry. However, it is our desire to come alongside you and help you to grow in your faith, leading you to the place where you are ready to become actively involved in ministry.

Proper Stewardship. We are called to be good stewards (*managers*) of all that God has blessed us with; our time, talent and resources. Therefore, it is important for you to support the church through your active involvement in ministry as well as providing financial support. To be more specific, God's Word defines something known as the tithe (*a tenth*). This is meant to be a basic foundational principal for giving (*providing a tenth of the resources God has given you*). Giving can and may exceed that percentage for those who are led by God to generously share; yet the Bible is clear that every child of God owes at least the tenth. Practically speaking your involvement in giving allows for the work of God to continue in this community and around the world.

Our Purpose Statement

Understanding **who** we are and **where** God is calling us is important. Our purpose statement clarifies what we are to do and how we are to carry out each task. We feel that it is important for each potential member to understand and agree with what we feel God is calling us to do. “Can two people walk together without agreeing on the direction?” Amos 3:3
